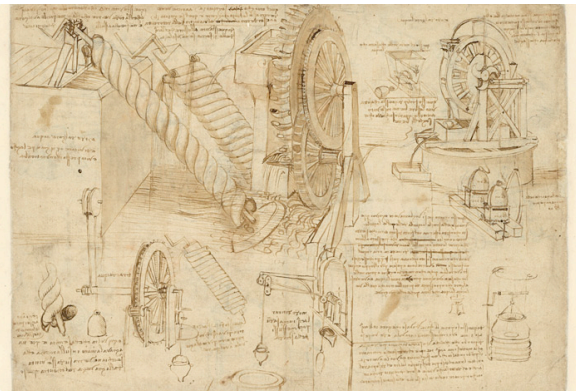
This summer you will have to do some work! If these tasks seem daunting to you, you may want to reconsider taking AP Studio Art

- A codex. This should be continuous and something that continues to evolve through the year.

What is a codex you ask? A codex is a collection of visual imagery that works as a database for you to pull from while working on your concentration and other work. The visual imagery can be, but is not limited to; drawings, paintings, photographs, journaling, poetry, figurines, lyrics, color swatches, magazine clipping, news stories, etc.

A codex can be one or all of the following; a sketchbook, digital folder or file, or a keepsake box

- 8-10 detailed, completed sketchbook drawings or thumbnails/photo shoot plans

- 3 completed artworks. Completed work means a well thought out and executed artwork that does not appear to be unedited or lacking in detail.
