



EXPLORE: Work-Based Learning (CO-OP)

Work-Based Learning Credit may be earned through CO-OP placements. Students have the option to be released from school early to participate in the work-based learning program. Students must already be employed in order to apply to participate in Co-op. Students are employed by a business that agrees to provide on-the-job training that *correlates with concurrent classroom instruction*. A school coordinator monitors the student's work performance. Students may earn 1 to 3 credits per year. An informational meeting will be held in May.

Students interested in Co-op, must select CO-OP as an <u>ALTERNATE</u>. <u>DO NOT</u> include CO-OP in your 7.0 credits. Schedules will be adjusted in fall after all paperwork is complete and approved.
