Speaking Final 20pts

Be prepared to have a conversation with 2-3 other classmates about your past stay at a hotel. You are expected to be polite and engage in basic small talk. You will need to use hotel vocabulary when you pose two questions and respond to two questions; one in the **passé composé (avec être)** to state completed events, one in the **imparfait** to describe the hotel, weather, or the room.

Writing Final 20pts

Be prepared to describe your fictitious, childhood home in a francophone region during your elementary school years mentioning rooms, furniture, and/or appliances. Include what you used to do there (household chores) and with whom. This will require you to use **Unité 8** vocabulary and to write in the **imparfait** when describing your fictitious francophone home and your past activities there.
