

# William R. Ladner Scholarship 2023

### **Description**

This is a \$1,000 scholarship generously sponsored by the Rotary Club of Howell in honor of William R. Ladner. This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has a strong emphasis on community service, academics, and extracurricular activities and who is planning to pursue a degree from a university or community college.

This scholarship is in honor of William R. Ladner, a long time Rotarian. The Howell Rotary Club was founded May 5, 1924 and is a service-oriented club made up of business and professional people in the community. Rotary club members are volunteers who work locally, regionally, and internationally under the motto "Service Above Self." We sponsor many fundraisers with money being dispersed to local and world-wide organizations to combat hunger, improve health and sanitation, provide education and job training, develop parks and recreational opportunities, promote peace, and eradicate polio. Our work advances international understanding, goodwill, and peace throughout a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in service.

#### Requirements

- Currently attending Howell High School and currently a senior.
- <u>Essay Required</u>: Explain why this 4 Way Test is an effective way to guide an individual's life. Minimum one page and 500 or more words.
- Current member of the Howell High School Interact Club and/or a minimum of 200 hours of community service within the last 4 years.
- Student who is planning to pursue a degree from a university or community college.
