All Howell High School students are eligible.

Applicants should possess and demonstrate the ability to benefit from further academic study.

At least one teacher (or other civic or social leader) who is willing to nominate the applicant and provide a letter of reference with the application must have recognized the applicant's potential. Generally, no more than two such letters should be submitted.

Applicants must also provide a complete high school transcript, a personal resume, and an autobiographical essay.

The personal resume should be complete and list any work experience as well as all school and community activities. (The HHS General Application form may be used but, if used, please provide all of the information requested below on that form, which will then satisfy this personal resume requirement.)

The autobiographical essay can be in any form, but the applicant should try to communicate who the applicant is and reflect why the applicant should be considered for one of these scholarships.

An applicant may wish to cover important influences, future plans, professional or academic goals or any other personal circumstances that the applicant considers appropriate for consideration.

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. An applicant must submit a single, complete application, to be considered for the Harris Family scholarships.

Finalists for the scholarships may be invited to personal interview.
