P.E.O. is a women’s international Philanthropic Educational Organization whose focus is raising scholarship money for women. This local scholarship is being awarded to a graduating senior girl who, through no fault of her own, has encountered obstacles to her completing her high school education, has overcome or is overcoming those obstacles and hardships, and has now enrolled in a college or technical school for the fall semester.

This scholarship will be at least \$300.

Requirements:

Graduating with a 2.5 GPA or higher

Brief letter describing obstacles or hardships overcome or being overcome

Two references from non-family members (either written or by phone)

Willing to keep Chapter EF informed on progress after starting post-secondary courses

Willing to have a photo taken with Chapter EF representatives

Willing to sign and date an agreement to the above requirements

Selection process:

- A small committee made up of P.E.O. Chapter EF members will interview the top candidates.
- The finalist will be selected by this P.E.O. committee and awarded the scholarship at the school’s scholarship night.
- The check for the scholarship will be made out to the local school district, which will then send the funds to the college or technical school in which the recipient has enrolled.
- IF, for some reason, the selected candidate decides not to go on to college or technical school, the scholarship will be awarded to the candidate next in line in the selection process.
- The chapter will be notified by the high school if this happens.
